### **Highly Recommended Way To Use This Report (But Not Mandatory)**

There are 10 stocks on this list. Of which six stocks have their charts inserted and the balance four do not because those need more time. Do not be apprehensive when you look at the large number of charts in the report. Take your time and go through each of the charts, one by one. Observe. Somethings will stand out; other things may not be so obvious. All the ticker symbols are hidden until the last page of the report. This is to encourage you to view the charts without a bias that comes with a known stock. You may recognize some charts or may not.

As you go through each stock, when you come to the end of the charts for each stock jot down your gut/instinct whether the stock fits into any of these three categories as shown in the table below. Basically, you are using your eyes and guessing which of the three stages these stocks belong to. When you come to the end of the report, the ticker symbols have been disclosed, and sample trading tables have been offered. But I recommend you paper trade them on your own and see if your classification of these stocks into these three stages before you paper traded them was correct. And compare your tables with the tables provided.

This second base placed a higher high and a higher low over the prior base. The breakout in mid-2024 above \$26.13 has continued to maintain an uptrend to date.

# Sample Trading Tables

**(Do Not Look At These Until After You Have Created Your Own Trading Tables, And Then You Can Compare)**

NOTE:

1. WTI's original trading table for all of 2020 and its 17 different trading tables since then are shown in January 2021 but not have presented you can do this on your own.

2. WTI's 17 trading tables since 2020 that ended in a stop but not have shown you can do this on your own. The WTI's monthly was used to make a different trading table, the WTI's monthly's low is used to get a stop at a low dollar before the month's low. The monthly has not shown in a new high yet.

3. WTI's has had two trading tables which have not have shown you can do it on your own.

4. WTI's moved from WTI to WTI, without offering the WTI's stop only due to the WTI's and its positive return over months of the WTI's.

5. WTI, WTI and WTI have offered a new way which have not have shown you can do this on your own.

6. While you might make different decisions, the approach will be the same.
