

January 2026 Decision Making Quiz

(There are TWO separate stocks)

When you see charts supplied by most services they almost always show you one chart for a stock's full move from a low to a high. And the usual marketing campaign, "If you had bought here, at the low at X, and sold here, at the high at Y, you could have quadrupled your money!"

After the fact, everybody has 20/20 vision and anyone can be right at each key point in the stock's journey. No one ever pushes and places you in spots that you face in live trading. Where at key points in a stock's journey you have to make decision or you have to let your stops make your decisions.

If you are serious and wish to test your decision-making skills, paper trade this stock using the following simple rules:

1. Be honest with yourself, otherwise you are cheating yourself.
2. You make one decision at a time. That means you cannot peek into the next page until the current page's decision has been inked in.
3. Your decision should be written down. Either on your own sheet or on this worksheet if you prefer to print this out.
4. Write down all aspects of the trade such as = How much did you buy? At what price? Where is the stop? How much will you lose if your stop gets hit?
5. Only after all this has been written down, do you go to the next page.
6. To make an already hard exercise easier, OHLC charts have been ignored.
7. There are TWO quizzes – Stock #1 and Stock #2. Same rules apply to both exercises.
