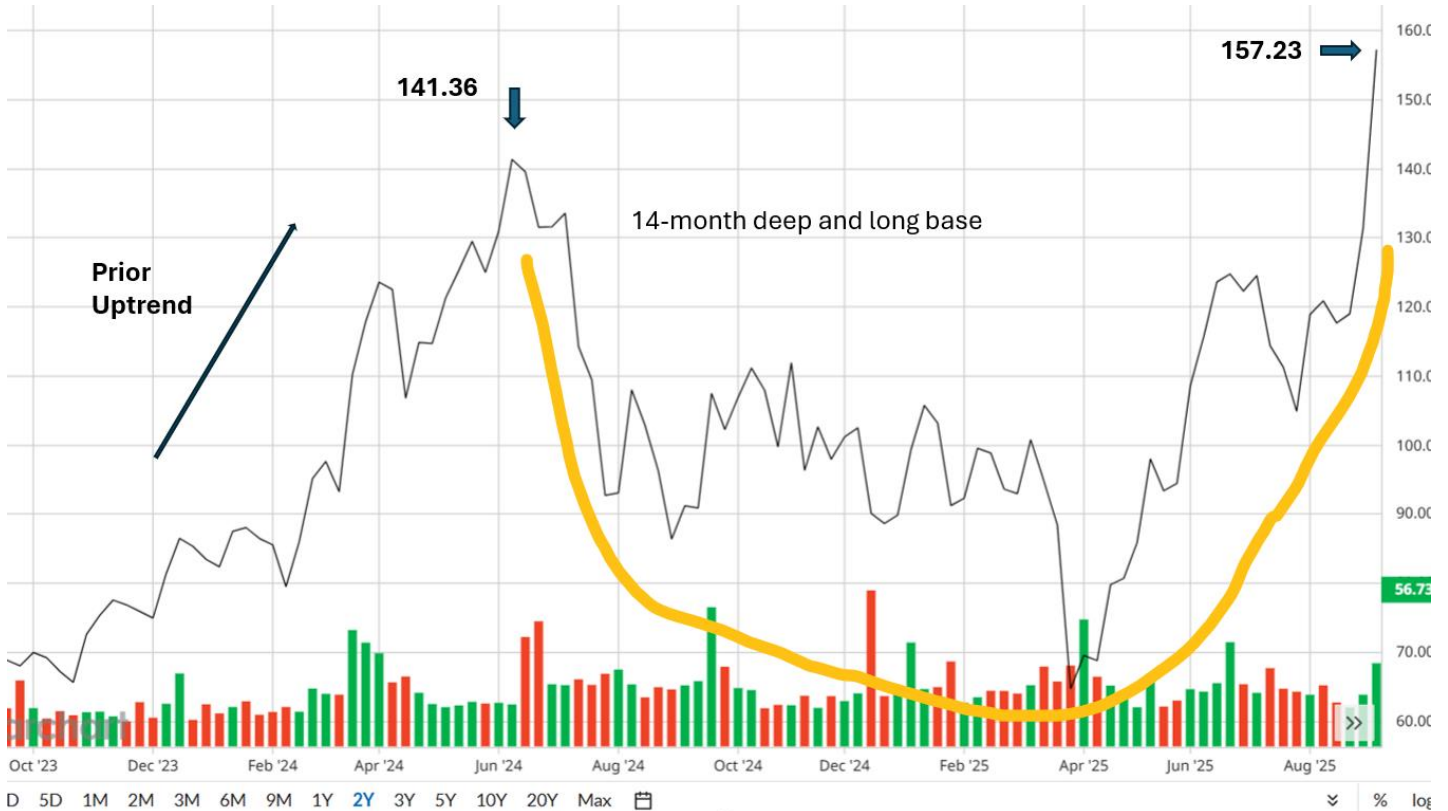


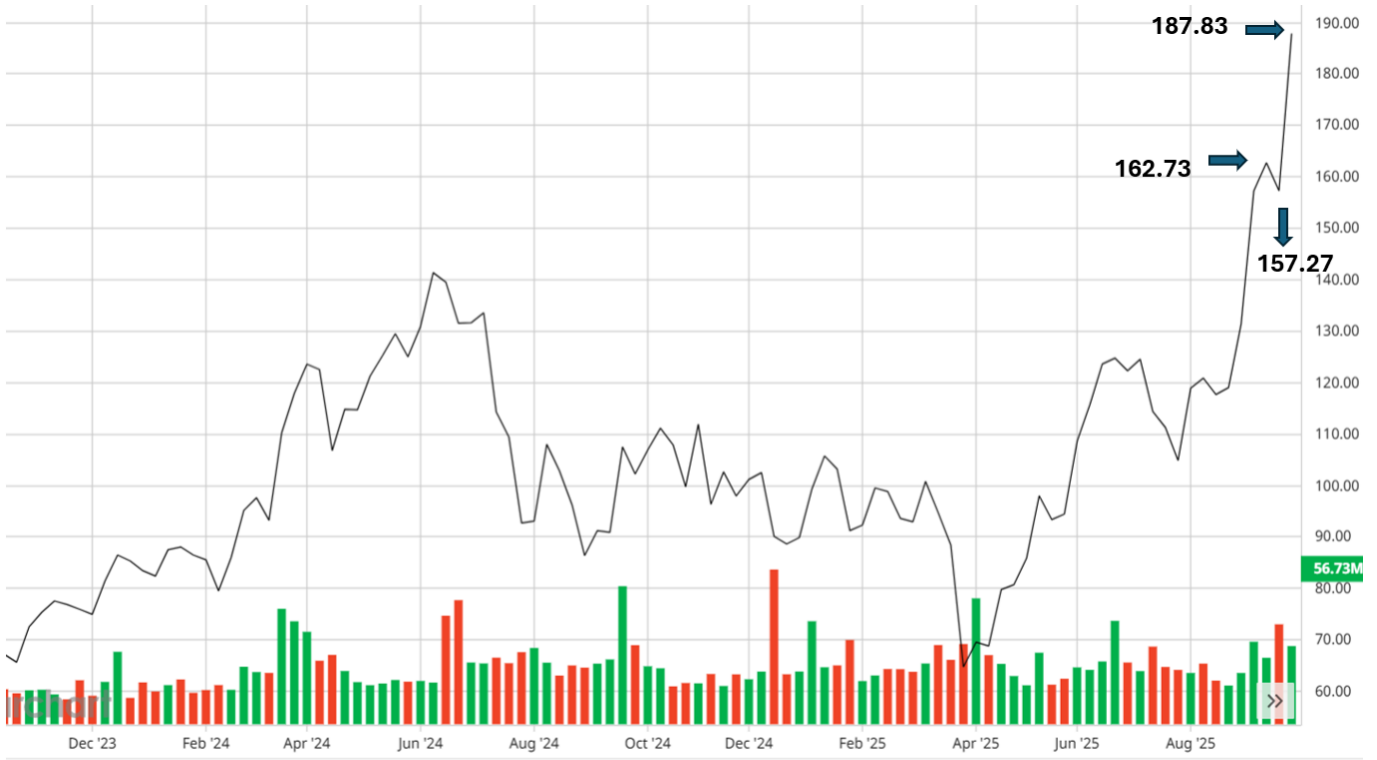
## The Perfect Practice

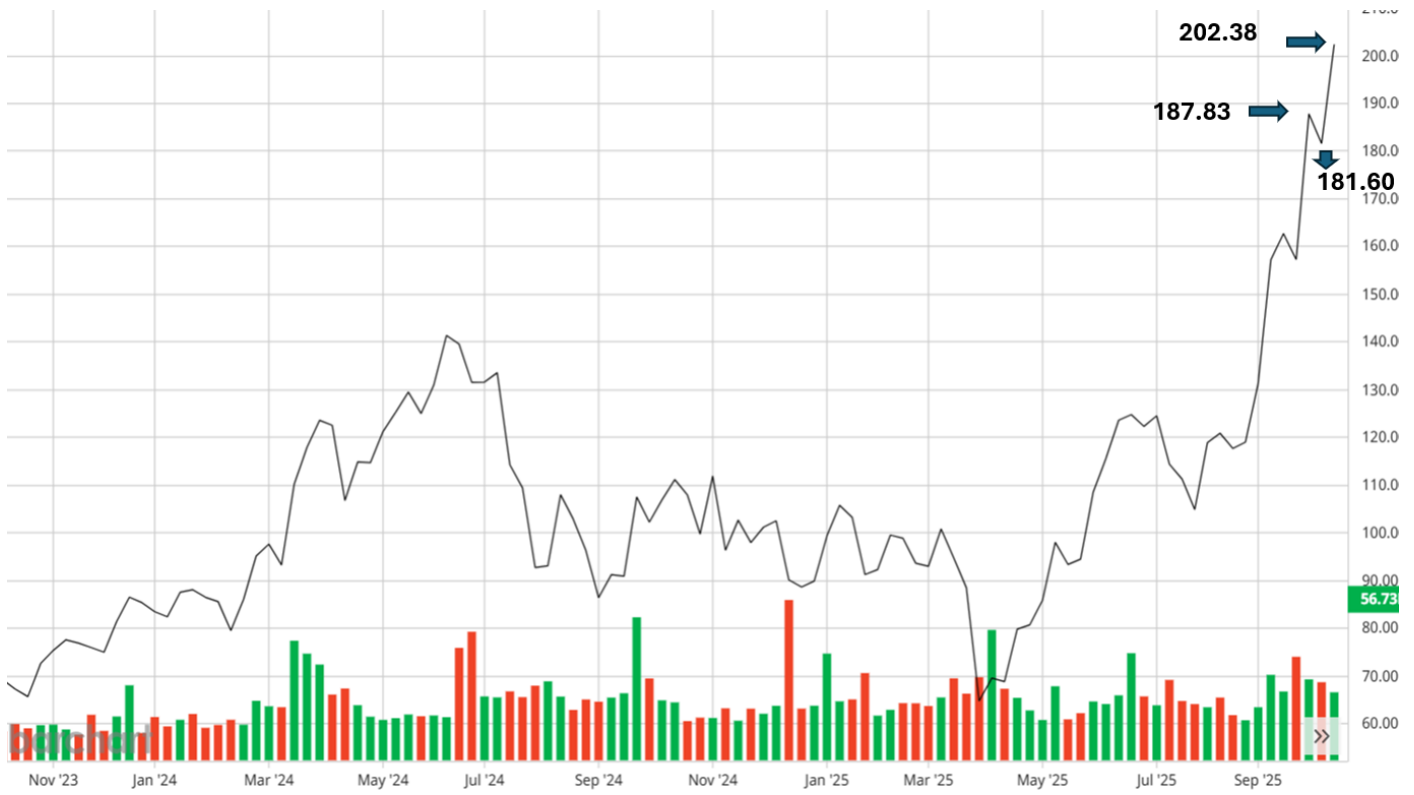

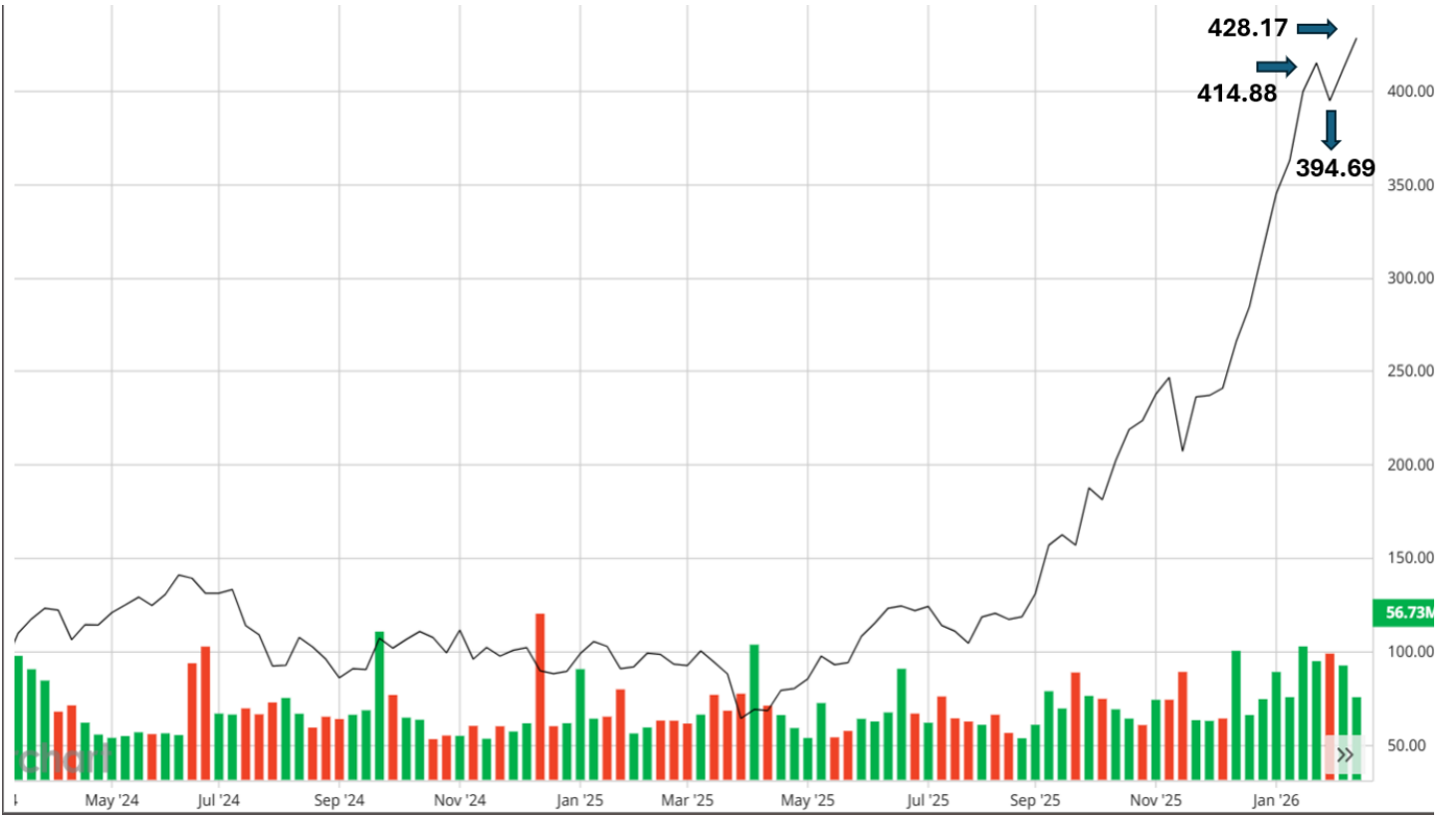


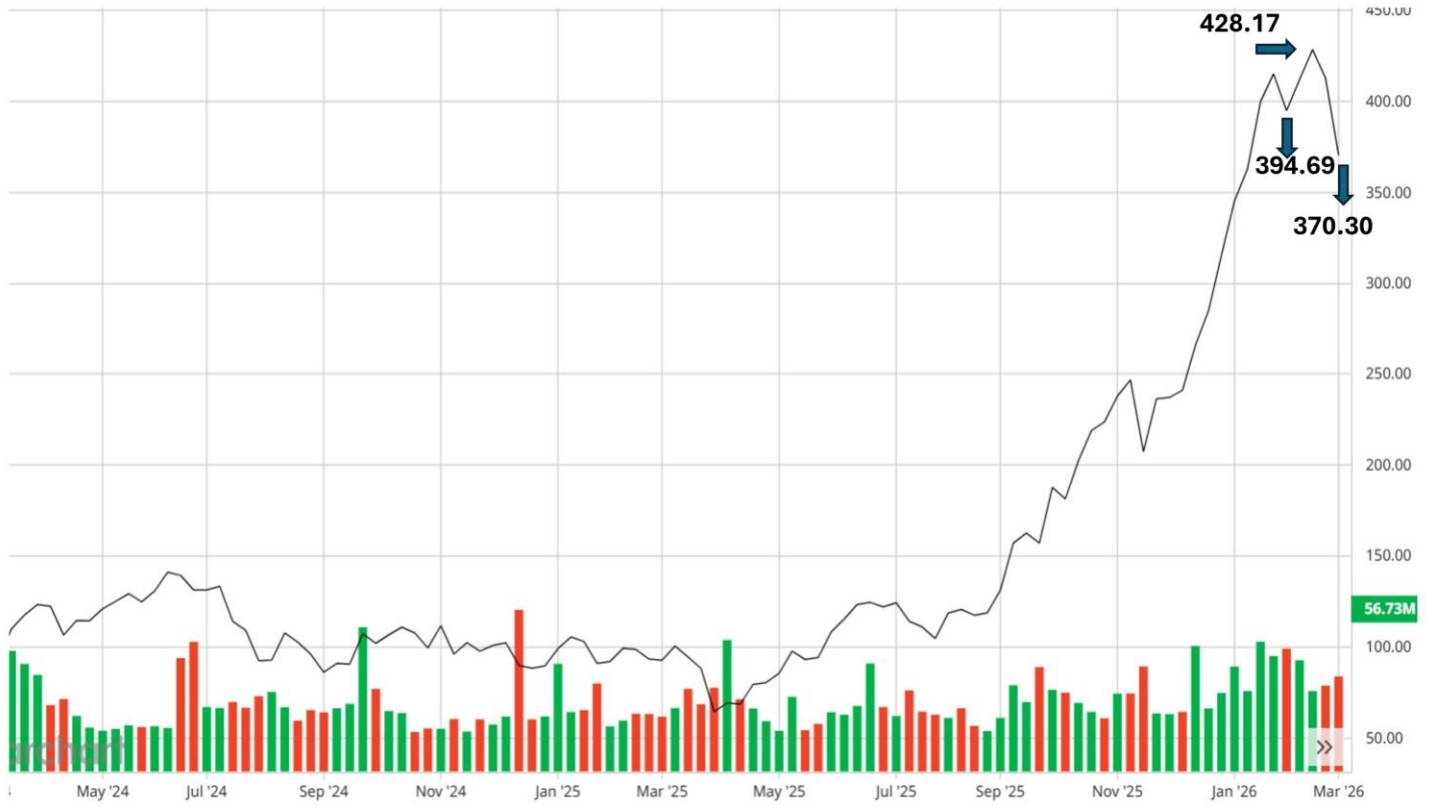
Write down your decision (and trades, if any). And repeat the process for each step (each page, one by one).

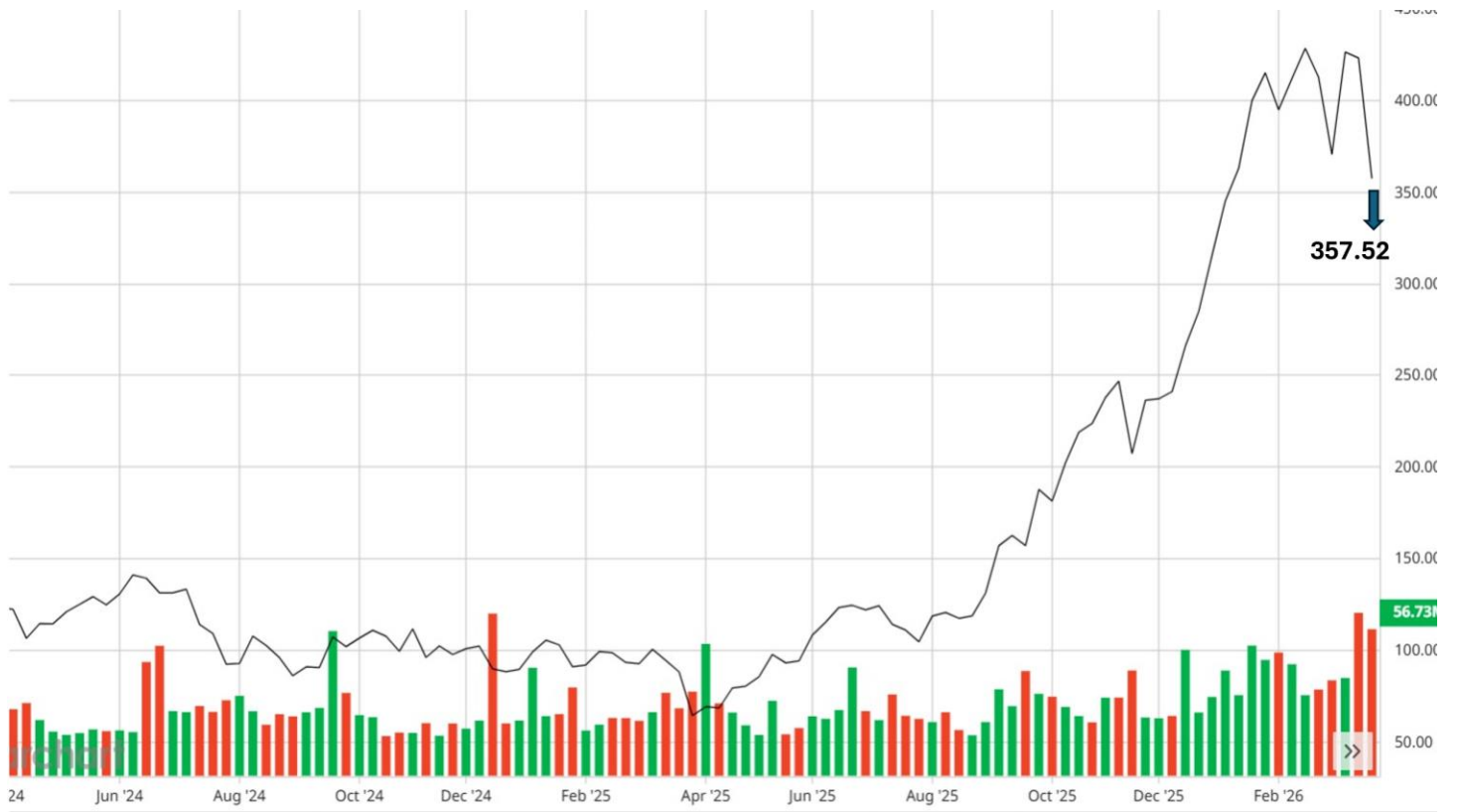




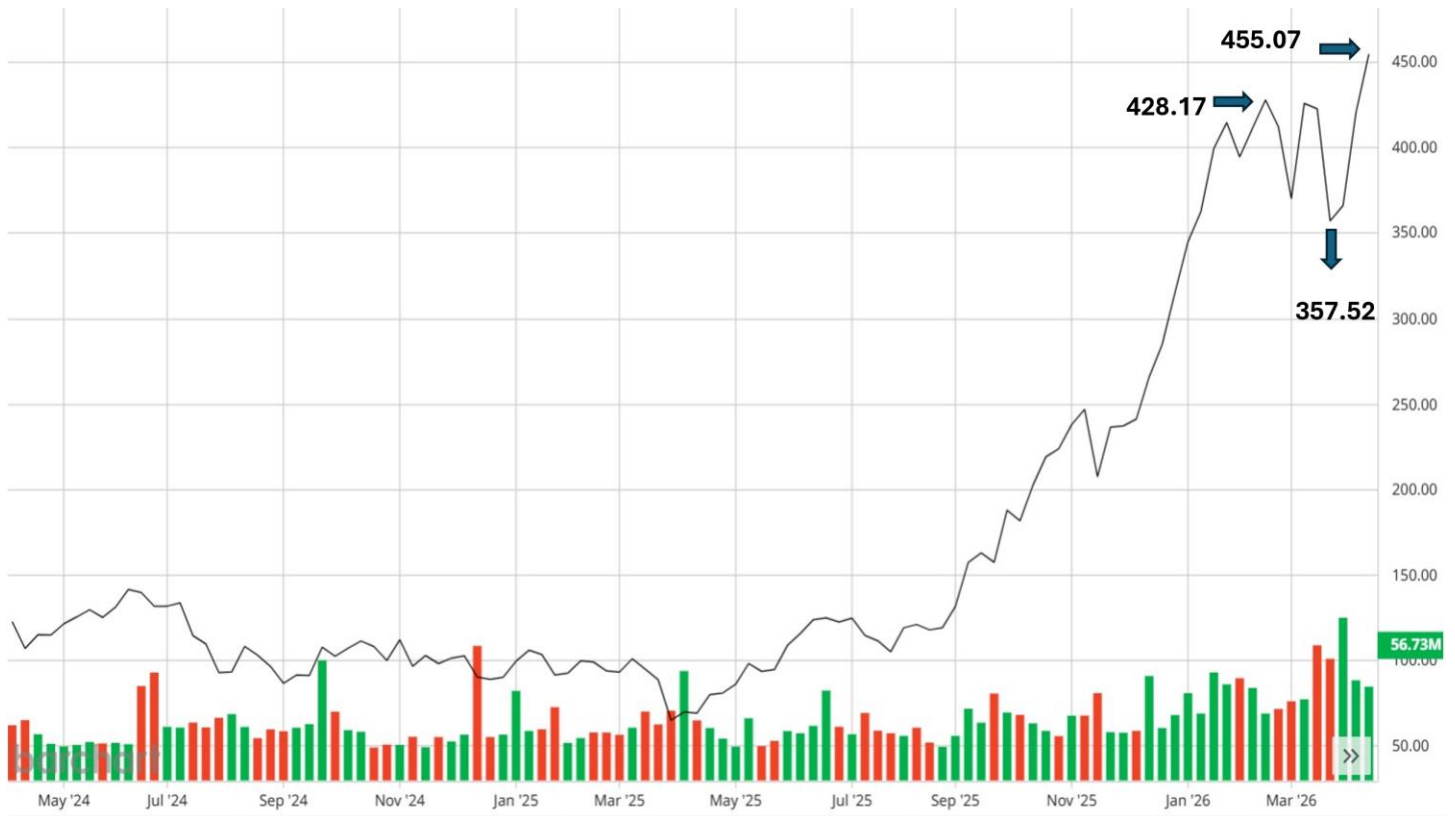




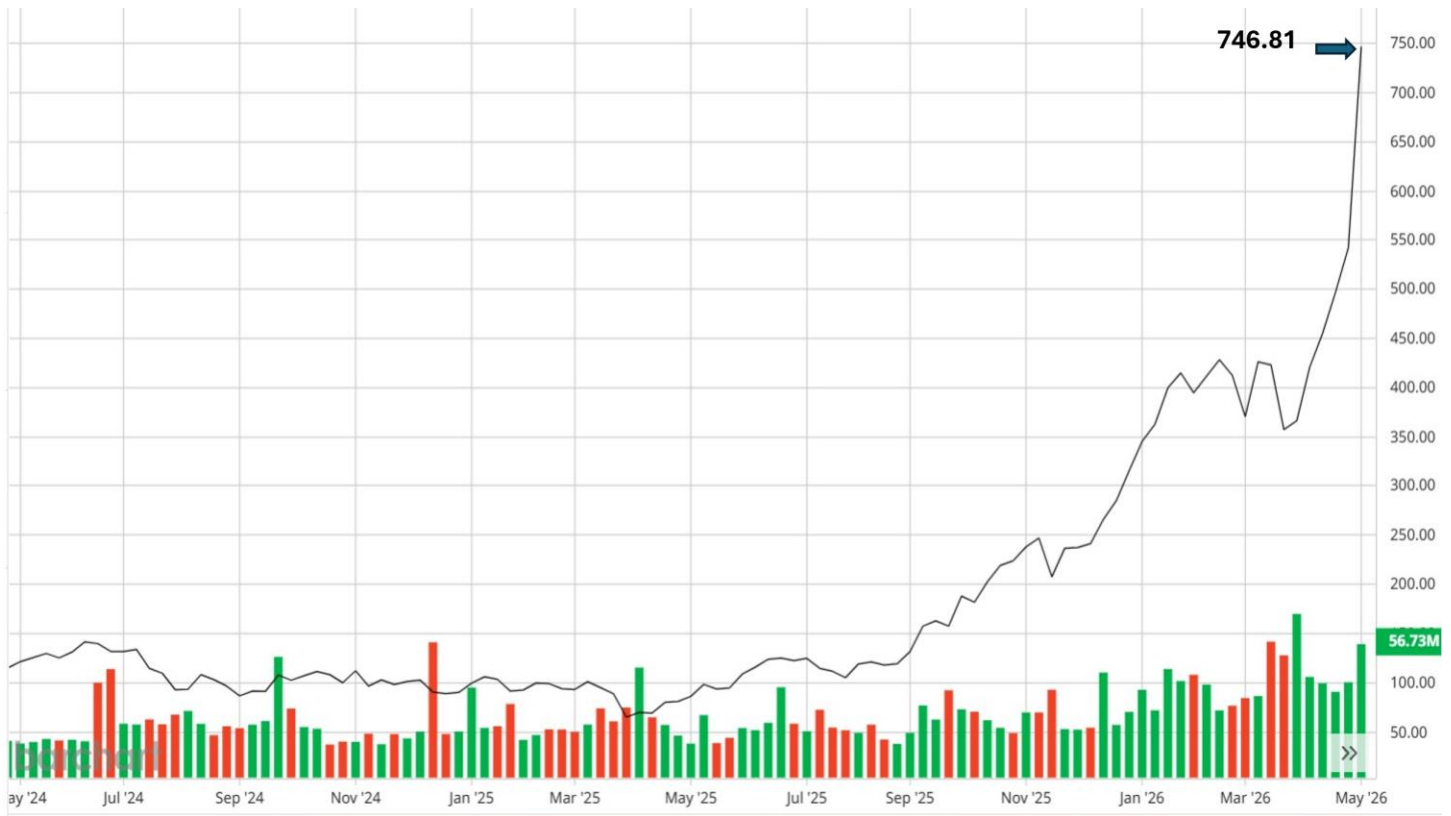




What are you seeing? Has the uptrend ended? Has your stop been hit?

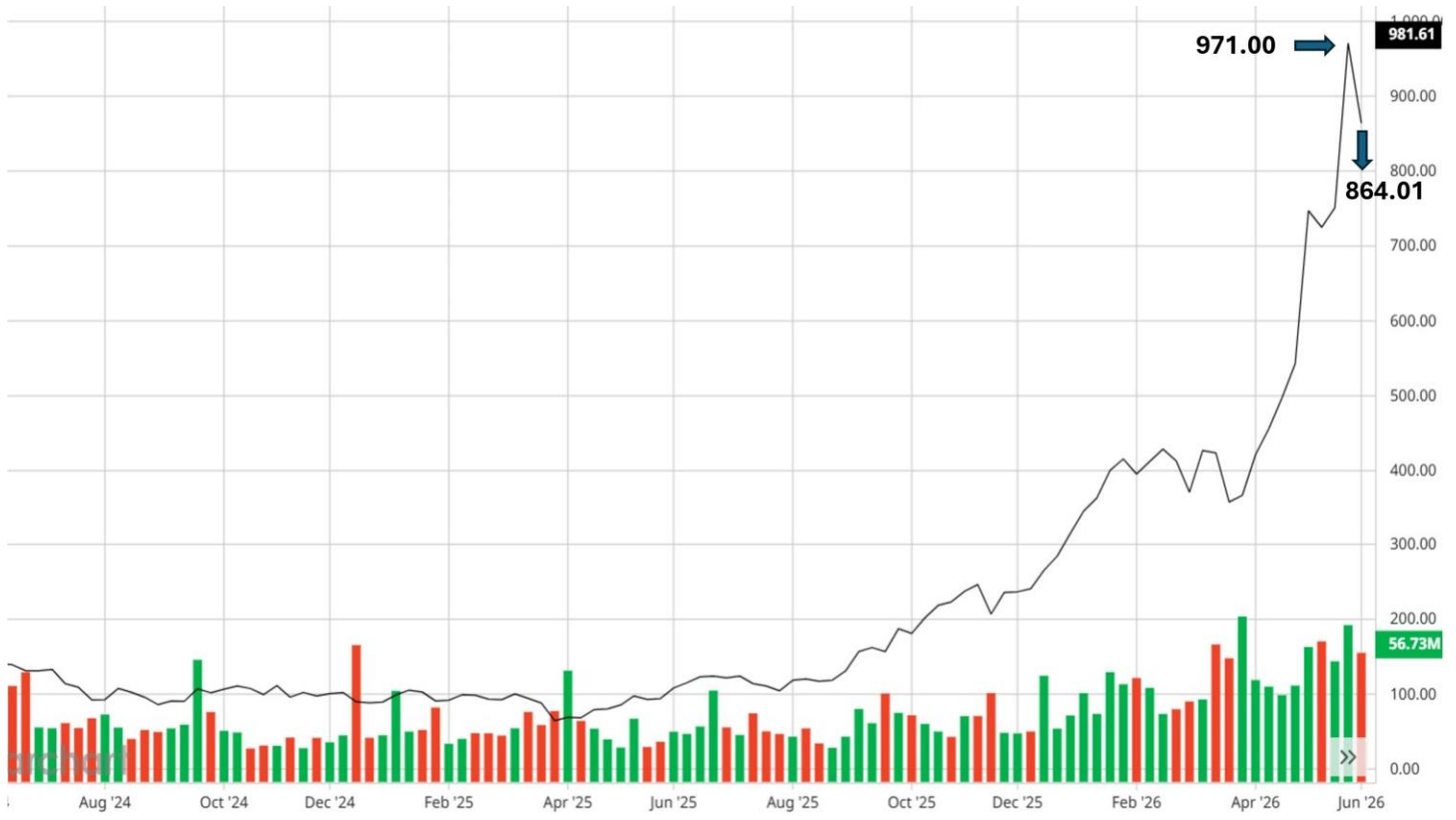


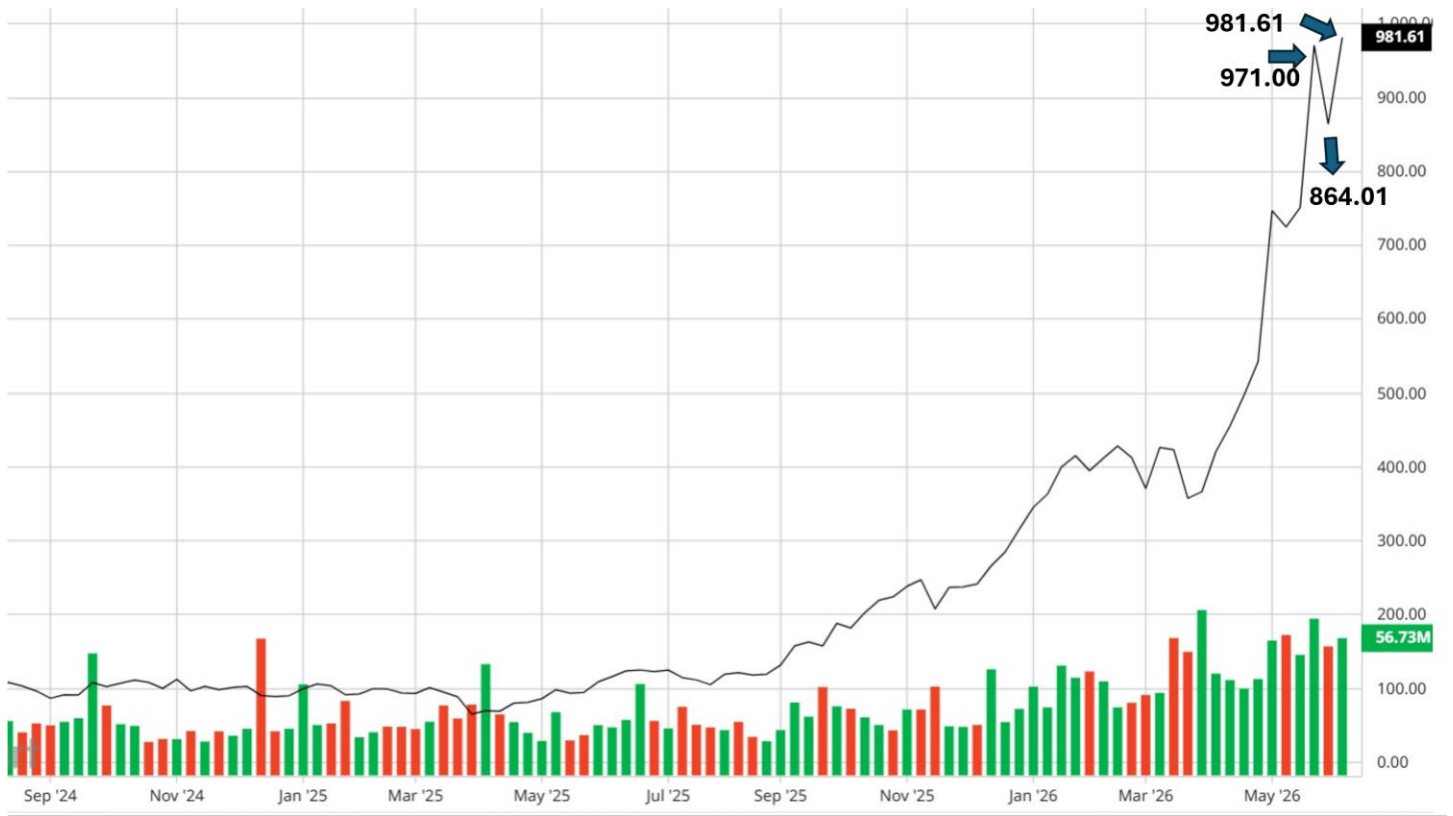
Did the stock whiplash us? Or is this just a head fake? What do you do?
